13.96	<p>APOLOGIES</p> <p>Apologies were received and accepted from Councillors P Duke and C Howard</p>
13.97	<p>MEMBERSHIP</p> <p>There were no changes to report.</p> <p>Members of the Council were reminded of their responsibility to declare any personal interest in respect of matters contained on the agenda.</p>

13.99	<p>MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES</p> <p>The Clerk reported on progress with the web site and the development of a content management system.</p> <p>The benches were to be delivered the following day and would be sited at Lodge Bank. The grit bin would be sited in Withnell Fold adjacent to the recently moved waste bin at the end of the Memorial Garden.</p> <p>Councillor Metcalfe reported he had met with Mr J Drinkall regarding the trees on Dick</p>

	<p>Lane. It had been suggested that other trees on route to Monks Hill (in Heapy) also be replaced. Mr Drinkall would dig holes and supply and fit [protective fencing but was concerned about tree cover which could prevent growth. The Chairman agreed to contact the Borough Council's Tree Warden to discuss the proposals and seek advice.</p> <p>No further news had been received regarding Abbey Village Play area, alternative sources of funding were being looked into by the Borough.</p> <p>(13.77) Councillor Metcalfe reported that the road signage had now been removed.</p> <p>(13.84) It was confirmed that once the web site was fully functioning that Quality Status would be sought as all the tests would be met. The clerk confirmed that all the information sought by Mr James had been provided and that no further contact had occurred.</p> <p>Councillor Crompton queried the invitation to Councillor Hansford. It was reported that Councillor Hansford had been invited and had received the papers but had sent her apologies on this occasion.</p> <p>The Chair suspended standing orders and invited County Councillor Snape to report on the County Council's views on fracking. Councillor Snape reported that the major issues perceived by the County Council related to gas storage, the impact on communities of repeated vehicle movements and compensation for the whole community affected. Planning applications were anticipated in 2014.</p> <p>Councillor Metcalfe expressed a view on a possible method of the distribution of compensation for the wider community. It was agreed that once more facts were available a further discussion on the impact of fracking could be held. It was anticipated that this would be around the time of planning applications.</p> <p>Councillor Snape explained that the planning application on Thirlmere Drive had been withdrawn whilst an ecological assessment was undertaken.</p> <p>It was confirmed the Bowland Mountain Rescue area covered the area to the north of the parish.</p>

The possibility of a charge on each house to pay for maintenance was suggested. • Drainage had been a problem at the first house on the un-adopted section of road as the run off was blocked by made up road. • Support had been given to Brinscall & Withnell junior football club.

13.105	<p>COUNCILLOR ISSUES</p> <p>Councillor Evans requested a copy of the full updated Parish Plan</p> <p>Councillor Evans requested that consideration be given to widening the pavement outside the post office on School Lane to allow for better vehicle exit from Withnell Fold Old Road. It was agreed to check if this was possible.</p> <p>Councillor A Perry reported on concerns regarding the welfare of pigs kept in an area at Lodge Bank. The boundary wall of the wall was considered a hazard, other gaps were</p>																								

	<p>covered in netting and animal welfare was considered an issue.</p> <p>Councillor Grime raised the issue of problem parking on Harbour Lane caused by a member of staff of the school. County Councillor Snape undertook to resolve the issue.</p> <p>Councillor Metcalfe reported on a number of thefts of stone and the potential theft of around 100 yards of stone walling. It was agreed to put an item on the web site (when operating) to remind of the prevalence of stone theft in rural communities.</p> <p>Councillor G France reported on the issues with regard the steps on Pleasant View, the provision of a bench and the need for a litter bin at that end of the park.</p> <p>Councillor Perry reported that there was still around 10 metres of path in that area to be repaired/improved and would contact Lindsey Blackstock regarding both matters.</p> <p>Councillor G France reported on that Peter Roworth was planning some green/eco/sustainable development at the end of Lodge Bank. He would discuss this with the Chair and report back.</p> <p>Councillor M France reported that;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • she had attended the Brinscall & District Drop in held at the BAWRA club at the top of School Lane. A member who attended on an electric scooter had access difficulties as there was no drop kerb at the car park entrance. It was agreed to raise this issue with LCC. • The ginnel on Larch Drive was in need of some form of lighting, possibly a street light. It was suggest that LCC may be the necessary point of contact. <p>Councillor Crompton enquired about progress with the speed indicator device. It was reported that the outcome of the speed survey being undertaken may help to inform the locations of the brackets to mount the Spid.</p> <p>Councillor Jones reported that;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A work day at Withnell Fold Memorial gardens was scheduled for 14th September • The wild flower meadow had not flowered and yellow rattle had taken over. The Parish Council were asked to assist with purchasing wild flower seed. The Chair agreed to discuss this with Lindsey Blackstock. • There were issues with deer in the orchard which may need resolving with fencing • The sign on Chorley Road which pointed to Withnell Fold had now been joined by another sign which indicated 'School', this had created an impact on the village sign. It was agreed to enquire how the signage had been placed and to seek to resolve the visual impact created by the two signs being placed in this way.
